A Brief Guide and Reference Sheet to *Robert's Rules of Order*

Robert's Rules of Order is a guide for conducting meetings and making decisions. In order for the Presbytery to carry out its responsibilities in the most fair and orderly fashion, it is helpful for teaching and ruling elders to understand the rules of order which will be followed. Familiarity with the *Book of Order* is very helpful and, where our constitution is silent, we have the following:

“Meetings shall be conducted in accordance with the most recent edition of *Robert's Rules of Order*, except when it is in contradiction to this Constitution. Councils may also make use of processes of discernment in their deliberations prior to a vote as agreed upon by the body.” [*Book of Order*, G-3.0105]

With this in mind, the following brief overview of parliamentary procedure is provided for you. It will serve as the basis for the handling of the Presbytery's business. Your familiarity and attention to these basic rules of order will be most appreciated.

Zoom meeting tips and reminders

This called meeting of the Presbytery of the James (POJ) will be held via the **meeting** format of the Zoom electronic meeting platform. Following are some key reminders about the conduct of the meeting. A full set of information and guidelines for this meeting are available on the Presbytery's website.

The schedule for the meeting is as follows –

9:00 a.m.	ZOOM meeting room opens
9:20 a.m.	brief review of Zoom features and tips
9:30 a.m.	meeting begins
12:30 p.m.	projected adjournment

There are only four pieces of business to be considered at this meeting, as detailed in the call of the meeting and presented in the Agenda. Everyone who wishes or needs to attend must register in advance. This process opens on November 5 and is available through 8 pm on Friday, November 20.

Persons who are family and friends of the ordination candidate, visitors, observing members of other presbyteries (both Teaching and Ruling Elders), and Ruling Elders who are not commissioners to this meeting, should register as a GUEST. Only those people attending as a voting commissioner (a Ruling Elder or Teaching Elder or Certified Educator) may vote on the items of business.

Participants are required to join the meeting on an individual device – one person on one device.

If you will be dialing into the meeting with a basic phone or if you think you might have any connectivity problems at all, please contact Barbara Espigh at the POJ office as soon as possible at barbara@presbyteryofthejames.org.

Make sure you have downloaded the latest version of Zoom to your device or computer.

Once you have registered for the meeting, you will receive an email confirmation, which will include a link to join the meeting. **Save that email** - you will need that link to join the meeting. Each registration generates a unique confirmation link, so you will not be able to share the link. This is one feature we rely upon to provide security and monitoring of the meeting.

TIPS FOR / DURING THE MEETING

- Join the meeting early - it takes a few minutes to join.
- Review the packet in its entirety in preparation for the meeting.
